- DFC Funding Update – Adjustment for Sue Wood
 - The CDC did not fund any Drug Free Communities grant for Year 1 or Year 6, the Notice of Funding Opportunity did not align with Executive Orders from the President.
 - Right now, there is no updated timeline on when they will want applicants to recompute, which means we may have to wait until the spring of 2026 with a grant start date of September 2026.
 - As the Board knows, Amanda resigned from her position due to personal life changes. Had she not, we as the Board would have to let her go due to these funding issues.
 - Diane, Carri, Katie and Sue discussed possible options to keep Sue on staff with the FRN, the following is being proposed to the Board to consider
 - Sue can work up to 20 hours per week (but has the intention of working less hours) for the next year and the funds coming from the Coalition line item
 - Katie moves to approve this proposal, Chuck seconds. All in favor, motion passes.
